Bond Election Includes Building Middle School No. 2

The Aledo ISD Bond Election will be held Tuesday, Nov. 7.

Proposition A of the Bond Election is \$64.19 million and includes the construction of middle school No. 2. Due to continued enrollment growth, Aledo Middle School is reaching its capacity. Nearly 900 students are currently enrolled at AMS in the 7th-8th grades for the 2017-2018 school year.

The location of middle school No. 2 is recommended for the north side of Interstate 20. The cost of the middle school was also reduced by the School Board from the original total presented by the Bond Steering Committee. The Board reduced the total to \$61 million.

Proposition A also includes repurposing McAnally Intermediate to an elementary school. More than \$3 million would be designated to convert the space to suit elementary-level programs.

The addition of McAnally as an elementary school would include closing Vandagriff Elementary, the oldest campus in Aledo ISD. The district is examining public-use possibilities for Vandagriff.

The new middle school reconfiguration would include 6th-8th grades. The current enrollment for grades 6th-8th is 1,310 students and that total is expected to grow to 1,666 by 2020 and 2,856 by 2026, per district demographic reports.
