Voter Registration Information for AISD Bond Election

The Aledo ISD Bond Election will be held Tuesday, Nov. 7.

To be an eligible voter, citizens must be registered to vote by Tuesday, Oct. 10. Voter registration cards are available at the 10 Aledo ISD school campuses and the administration building, located at 1008 Bailey Ranch Road.

Citizens can also visit the Parker County Elections webpage for a voter registration form, which must be filled out and returned by mail. Early voting in the November election begins Oct. 23 at the Aledo ISD Administration building from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.
